Dear Mr President,

Thank you very much for your information regarding the postponed meeting of the Ukraine – NATO Inter - parliamentary Council in Brussels. We fully support your, Mr President, decision, especially regarding the necessity of ensuring an inclusive and qualitative dialogue with the representatives of all political forces of Ukrainian delegation.

Understanding the situation and the current developments in Ukraine, we strongly condemn the use of excessive force against peaceful demonstrators by the Ukrainian authorities. We find this response doesn't befit a democracy and can not be accepted. Therefore, to enable the dialogue with all political forces in Ukraine, we for our part wish to propose taking into consideration organization of the rescheduled UNIC meeting as soon as possible and preferably in Kiev. Such meeting would engage both the opposition and the government in the dialogue, allow constructive assessment of the current situation in Ukraine and would illustrate the principle of transparency of the Assembly activities.

The situation in Ukraine is unquestionable a matter of great importance for our Assembly and the whole transatlantic region. We believe that the forthcoming meeting would be the most opportune moment for the debate on the NATO – Ukraine relations. We would appreciate your consideration of our proposal for the UNIC meeting in Kiev as soon as possible.
